Supplement 4: Prescribing for alcohol dependence

Alcohol withdrawal

Alcohol dependence and withdrawal may be treated in inpatient settings. Alcohol dependence may occur in combination with dependence on other classes of drugs. Where there is a history of alcohol and benzodiazepine use, a benzodiazepine withdrawal schedule as outlined above may be used. The Severity of Alcohol Dependence Questionnaire (SADQ) (Stockwell et al., 1979) can be helpful in measuring the severity of alcohol dependence
