Methadone detoxification regimen

Methadone detoxification needs to be distinguished from a slow reduction of methadone down to zero. In the detoxification regimen the usual preparation needs to be done and a momentum for change generated so that a drug free state is reached within 2-3 weeks.

A significant number of patients supplement their methadone prescriptions when the dose falls below 20mg daily and this holds true for either slow reduction or detoxification regimens. Thus the regime is best suited to more stable patients with positive alternatives to drug use established.

Seven days after the last dose of methadone the patient can be started on naltrexone.
