

Clinical Medication Review – practice computer template

Clinical details

- Each medicine has an appropriate indication and there is no unnecessary duplication.
- There is evidence for the efficacy for each medicine.
- There is no evidence of side effects or the side effects are acceptable.
- There are no clinically relevant drug interactions or contraindications.
- The drug, dose or dosing schedule is appropriate.
- Any other drugs (including OTC, alcohol and illegal drugs) that the patient takes regularly have been identified.
- Under treatment of a condition has been identified and an explanation given if an “evidence based” medicine has not been prescribed.

Technical details

- The choice of medicine is the most cost effective
- The quantities of regular repeat medicines are the same
- The instructions on the prescription are clear and informative

Adherence details

- The patient has been interviewed to explain the purpose of each drug and a check has been made on whether he/she wants to carry on taking it.
 - Any physical problems the patient has in using there medicine has been corrected e.g can't open child proof containers
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
