Important Points from the Questionnaire to Trainers on Needs in IT Use in Training

We sent a questionnaire to trainers in 2003.

Specific requests for training were actually quite few – most just saying “I needs more training”. Those that mentioned specific areas asked for:

- 1) Using net based resources to find information
- 2) Sharing good web-sites
- 3) Using decision support software in the consultation
- 4) Use of PowerPoint in teaching
- 5) Sharing good CD based resources
- 6) Access

(items only included if mentioned more than once)

In the light of this, priority areas seem to be:

- 1) Use of IT in the consultation and decision support software
- 2) Use of IT in teaching situations – the tutorial
the presentation
- 3) Information Management – finding information
handling information
- 4) Developing and Sharing resources

Suggestions for homework:

- 1) Think about a tutorial or series of tutorials that you would like to work on for your GP registrar that is about, or makes significant use, of IT
- 2) Think about a presentation you would like to be able to give, including relevant web-links
