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Subject	Bradford Response for Frailty in COVID 19

Top Tip 1	<ul> <li>What is Frailty and how do we measure it?</li> <li>'Frailty' refers to a person's mental and physical resilience, or their ability to bounce back and recover from events like illness &amp; injury</li> <li>Rockwood Clinical Frailty Score has been used by NICE to define frailty</li> <li>See Top Tips in using CFS - remember it is not suitable for &lt; 65 years old or those with a single fixed disability</li> </ul>
Top Tip 2	<ul> <li>Why is it important in COVID and what else affects outcomes?</li> <li>NICE have used the CFS as part of a holistic assessment to help decision making in Critical Care for Adults with COVID NICE – Covid-19 rapid guideline: critical care in adults</li> <li>IT DOES NOT INCLUDE &lt; 65yrs or People with LD</li> <li>NICE has shown that Critical Care mortality and hospital mortality increased with age, cardiovascular &amp; respiratory co-morbidity and frailty</li> <li>NICE – information to support decision making</li> </ul>
Top Tip 3	<ul> <li>What services have we developed in Bradford to support Frail patients</li> <li>Bradford Frailty Pathway (see the attached slides)</li> <li>MyCare24 - A 24/7 service any GP/ANP/DN can ref too: to support patients in their own home BUT YOU NEED A PLAN - Refer via System One &gt; Frail Patient Template</li> <li>Immedicare - The service for ALL Care Home residents, they are automatically enrolled</li> <li>Gold Line - Remember if your patient is in the last year of life, put on the GSF and refer to GOLD line (all electronic via EPPACS)</li> <li>Hear more about the service by watching our Podcast</li> </ul>
Top Tip 4	<ul> <li>How to get more clinical support</li> <li>The CCG has set up a 'Super Rota' of Clinicians - Care of Elderly Consultants, GPwSI and experienced GPs running from 8am -Midnight out of the Digital Care Hub at AGH</li> <li>The Super Rota supports complex decision making following the principles from the RCP Supporting implementation of NICE critical care guidelines</li> <li>Use the paper Escalation Tool developed on visits or as a referral letter or Use the new System One Template in the COV-19 Clinician Console available through ASSIST</li> <li>Access the Super Rota by referring the patient to MyCare24 or if they are in a Care Home calling the Digital Care Hub on 01535 292764</li> <li>The Super Rota are also running an hour long 'Huddle' every day to support each other &amp; we are happy to have community staff join in.
